**Seasonal Weight Restrictions Permit Procedures:**

- 1) Milk Haulers – No charge. Permit allowed for blacktops, but must use minimal distance. 35 mph speed limit.**
- 2) Farm Commodities – No charge for gravel roads. Haul time period will be from 4:00 am to noon. 35 mph speed limit.**
  - Class B (paved roads) Must bond road at \$10,000 per mile to receive permit. (only exception will be on a day to day basis for morning trips if temperatures were below 25 degrees through night and into morning – 4 am to 10 am only) 35 mph speed limit. Must have written approval by either Robb Falls or Dale Stolicker.**
- 3) Public Utility – “During a Emergency Only” Must give notification 24 hour (fax # 810-648-5810) of the location of the emergency and equipment used that exceeded the weight limits. Must use Class A routes when possible to minimize the travel on a restricted road. No charge for use of restricted county roads, during weight restrictions. 35 mph speed limit.**
- 4) All other trucking operations (sand, gravel, lumber, steel, etc...) - No charge for gravel roads. Haul time period will be from 4:00 am to noon. 35 mph speed limit.**
  - Class B (paved roads) \$10,000 per mile bond is not a option. (only exception will be on a day to day basis for morning trips if temperatures were below 25 degrees through night and into morning – 4 am to 10 am only) 35 mph speed limit. Must have written approval by either Robb Falls or Dale Stolicker.**
